

NOTES:

- 1. Drawing in millimetres unless noted otherwise.
- Trees are to be of good form, health, structure and free of pests and disease. Tree species to be chosen in collaboration with the City of Port Phillip Urban Landscapes Branch.
- 3. Rocks/clods greater than 50mm shall be broken down or removed.
- 4. Topsoil shall not be cultivated into underlying soil layers.
- 5. Tree roots shall be protected from drying influences such as sun, wind and frost.
- All trees shall be set plum in the centre of the hole and placed to ensure a normal relationship of the crown to the soil surface.
- 7. Where excavation will occur, contractor must conduct a Dial Before You Dig (www.1100.com.au).
