

- Drawing in millimetres unless noted otherwise.
- All weeds shall be removed from the planting areas prior to planting.
- 3. The subgrade shall be cultivated to a depth of 250mm min.
 - Rocks/clods greater than 50mm shall be broken down or removed.
 - Topsoil shall not be cultivated into underlying soil layers.
 - Trees are to be of good form, health, structure and free of pests and disease. Tree species to be chosen in collaboration with the City Of Port Phillip
- 7. Plant roots shall be protected from drying influences such as sun, wind and frost.
- 8. Thoroughly water plants prior to planting.
 - The location of plants is to be established prior to further preparation works.
- 10. All plants shall be set plum in the centre of the hole and placed to ensure a normal relationship of the crown to the soil surface.
- 11. All non-native plants shall be fertilised and watered in after planting at the following rates:
 - 200mm pot 'Osmocote' (Long life) 2 teaspoons (20g)
 - 150mm pot 'Osmocote' (Long life) 1.5 teaspoons (15g)
- 12. Where excavation will occur, contractor must conduct a Dial Before You Dig (www.1100.com.au).
