



TREE PIT IN ASHPALT PAVING PLAN

NOTES:

- 1. Drawing in millimetres unless noted otherwise.
- 2. The surface treatment of the tree pit can be 50mm of compacted granitic gravel or permeable pebble mix paving 'spring rockpave' (or equal approved). The preferred treatment for tree pits particularly in high use areas is permeable mix.
- 3. Tree pit sizes vary to suit site conditions:
 - Minimum size : 1200mm x 1200mm - Preferred size : 1500mm x 1500mm
 - Large size : 2000mm x 2000mm
- Where excavation will occur, contractor must conduct a Dial Before You Dig (www.1100.com.au).
