

**Community should be consulted about project for at least 14 days.**  
Letter to be distributed to local residents and other stakeholders (as appropriate)  
Signs might be erected on site (as appropriate)  
Public advertisement for projects likely to have broader municipal wide appeal (as appropriate)  
Residents are invited to make a submissions

**Should opposition to the project be received that cannot easily be negotiated;**  
The General Manager will facilitate a meeting with the ward Councillor and submitters  
That meeting will hear and clarify submissions  
The meeting will consider any expert advice  
The meeting will attempt to negotiate an outcome with the stakeholders

**Opposition withdrawn**  
Resident or stakeholder withdraws opposition to the project proposal,

**Negotiated solution**  
Resident/stakeholders and Council reach a compromise on the project proposal.

**Maintained Opposition**  
No resolution can be reached.  
The decision will be referred to Council for a decision

**Negotiated outcome**  
Project proceeds

**Council decides**  
Resident or stakeholder is invited to attend the Council meeting and address Council.  
Council will amend project proposal and/or, commence project or place proposal on hold
