15 Nov - 19 Dec 04	The National Theatre Past and Present: Celebrating 70 years of Service to the Community	Regarded as an icon in St Kilda, the National Theatre has been part of the life of the Port Phillip community since 1920. This exhibition celebrates its history through photography and costume display.
22 Oct - 12 Nov 04	IntoArt Portraits	An exhibition of luminous watercolours and pastels created by participants of IntoArt, a class tutored by Giz James at Gasworks Arts Park for people with special needs.
30 Sept - 21 Oct 04	Urban Heart Surgery	Urbanism in the Metropolis. 4th Year Architecture students from Deakin University, Geelong present design initiatives for the South Melbourne Central Precinct and the Port Melbourne Water Front Gateways.
6 Sept - 29 Sept 04	Learn for Yourself	Contemporary small works completed by a local Port Phillip art group whose members reside in Rooming Houses. Marvellous artworks are produced using limited materials and within a 2 hour time restriction per work.
30 July - 3 Sept 04	Port Phillip Specialist School Art	Art work from children of Port Phillip Specialist School.
5 July - 26 July 04	Art from the Heart	An exhibition of paintings and drawings by homeless and disadvantaged people from boarding houses, SRS homes and hostels in the St Kilda area and visitors and members of the Sacred Heart Mission's art groups.
1 June - 30 June 04	Cross Cultural Flavours	An exhibition and celebration of people, their art and the experience of migration. Works explore what Melbourne means to people who have either moved to the Port Phillip area from overseas or from within Australia, and the subsequent influences on their art practice.
4 May - 28 May 04	Celebrating people, places and communities. An exhibition for Housing Week 2004	A return showing for the 'Strengthening Communities 2003 Photographic Exhibition' - highlighting local residents enjoying a range of activities. Works reflect and acknowledge diverse meanings of place in Port Phillip.
5 April -	Exhibition of works	Port Phillip artist Meredith Whiting's

30 April 04	by artist Meredith Whiting	exhibition contains twenty framed watercolours and several mixed media and sculpture pieces. Her works depict 'dreamlike scenes, and natural forms of flora and fauna and the imaginary possibilities that spring from personal narrative.'
8 March - 2 April 04	The World We Live In - Art Exhibition by the Positive Living Centre	It is extraordinary that after 20 years of HIV/AIDS basic levels of ignorance still exist in our community. 'Fresh' is an initiative of the Positive Living Centre that offers social support information and resources to HIV positive young people. These images show a young HIV positive perception of the world we live in.
10 February - 5 March 04	Port Phillip People and Places - Emerald Hill Art Group	The Emerald Hill Art Group's 3rd annual exhibition of paintings. Artists' work presents not only Port Phillip's well-known and loved sights, but also some more private aspects of their experience. Portraits, landscapes, interiors and still life paintings capture some of the character and essential spirit of our environment.
