## Position Description

A gardening group providing gardening services to the elderly and disabled who are unable to care for their own gardens, but still live independently.

This volunteer position requires a commitment of (min.) 3 hours per week.

The aim of the program is to assist in the garden of the frail, elderly individual who is unable to maintain their garden on their own.

To maintain garden on an ongoing basis as arranged with CCCC.

To work with one other volunteer to weed, and general tidying up of garden.

To compost debris where possible either in compost bin or into the garden, or where necessary arrange with CCCC disposal of debris.

To take time out with the client where there is a need for social connection.

Training and support in working with clients will be provided.
