Vacancy Name: Volunteer Recreation Worker

Tasks / Duties: Volunteers are required to work with children with disabilities in regular youth groups, school holiday programs and camps. The recreation programs offer a range of activities including excursions, picnics, movies, swimming and much more (all volunteer activity expenses are covered by Interchange Southern). These programs provide children with the opportunity to make new friends and develop self-confidence as well as providing valuable respite for the Child's family members.

Skills & knowledge: No formal qualifications are necessary. An interest in working with children with disabilities is an advantage.

Time commitment:

Days required: Saturdays or Sundays or during the school holidays

Location of position: Interchange Southern provides services to families in the Southern Metropolitan region of Melbourne including the cities of Port Phillip, Bayside, Kingston, Glen Eira and Stonnington.

Special Requirements: Satisfactory completion of the screening process, including a Police Check and references are required.

Extra Comments: Individual and groups training is provided.

Volunteers support the children on a 1:1 basis under the supervision of an Interchange staff member.
