



# DOG OFF LEASH AREAS

## Where to walk your dog

DOGS may be exercised off leash in a designated off leash area – provided they are under effective control; this means immediate response.

Off leash activities are restricted to specified areas and/or times in some reserves and beaches. Please read the signs carefully when entering the reserve.

City of Port Phillip promotes responsible dog ownership

DOGS must be walked on a lead in all public areas other than those signed as "off leash"

DOGS AND CATS are prohibited in the following environmentally sensitive areas.

- Perce White Reserve, Port Melbourne
- West Beach, St Kilda (only area indicated by map)

BEACH RESTRICTIONS apply between 1 November and 31 March each year.

DOG LITTER Owners of dogs should ensure they have a plastic bag or an acceptable item to clean up after their dogs as failure to do so can result in an infringement being issued.
