

CALL FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

Proposal to determine the mayoral & councillor allowances

For the period 1 July 2009
to 30 June 2013



Victorian councils are required to review and determine the payments made to councillors after every council general election.

A State Government Order in Council was published in the Victorian Government Gazette in December 2008 setting the range of payments for mayors and councillors for the three categories of Victorian councils. Port Phillip Council is a category 3 council and currently the following maximum payments apply:

- Mayoral payment - \$84,257 per annum
- Councillor payment - \$26,378 per annum

The mayor and councillors of Port Phillip are currently in receipt of the maximum payments for a category 3 council and it is proposed for the period 1 July 2009 to 30 June 2013 that the mayor and councillors continue to receive annually the maximum payments.

Port Phillip Council is seeking community input into this proposal and will receive written submissions up until the **close of business Thursday 2nd April 2009**.
