### **This planning permit is reactivated:**

This application was lodged December 2005 and public notice was given in early 2006.

The application has been on hold until such time as Parks Victoria produced a Concept Plan for the St.Kilda Harbour to satisfy the requirements for a Coastal Management Act consent from the Department of Sustainability and Environment (DSE).

That Concept Plan work has been undertaken and DSE has issued its Coastal Management Act consent.

The Planning application must now be determined by Council. It is intended that the application be considered by Council at its Statutory Planning Committee meeting on Tuesday **9 June 2009** at 6pm. Objectors/submitters will be further advised of the details of that meeting.
