Some Tips for Travelling on Trams



Before Your Journey

1. Plan your destination before you leave home
2. Buy your ticket before getting on the tram
 - Metcards can be pre-purchased from Metlink or selected Newsagents
 - Call Metlink on 131638 to find your closest retailer or to have your Metcard delivered to your home
 - Ask a family member or friend to buy your tickets whilst they're out
3. Limit your hand luggage
4. Put your ticket in an easily accessible pocket

During Your Journey

- Board at the front door
- Once on the tram find a seat nearest the driver
- Ask for a seat if there are none available
- Validate your ticket only when the tram is stationary or ask another passenger to validate for you
- Always hold onto the hand rails when moving through the tram
- Push the next stop button well in advance
- If you can't get to a button, ask a nearby passenger to push the button for you
- If you miss your stop, don't panic, just get off at the next stop, cross the road and wait for the tram in the opposite direction
