



# Liardet Street Family and Children's Centre TRAFFIC & CARPARKING



The City of Port Phillip is building an integrated family and children's centre in Port Melbourne.

## Traffic and Carparking

An independent Traffic Impact Assessment has been conducted to assess potential traffic and parking impacts for the surrounding area.

The assessment found that:

- Child Care Centres have staggered arrival and departure times usually between 7:00 to 9:30am in the morning and 3:30 to 6:30pm in the afternoon.
- Parents dropping or collecting their children usually park for approximately five to ten minutes at a time.
- To help accommodate this increase the report recommends increasing street parking by 17 spaces.
- The new development is not expected to create adverse safety, capacity or operational problems in the area.

Based on these findings council is proposing to:

- Increase street parking by 20 spaces.
- On-street parking will be reconfigured along the East side of Esplanade West and Dow Street to accommodate the extra parking.
- A new pickup and drop off zone will be created in Liardet Street.
