



Liardet Street Family and Children's Centre SERVICES



The City of Port Phillip is building an integrated family and children's centre in Port Melbourne. Three levels of government are funding this centre: Federal (\$1.6M), State (\$1.2M), Council (\$2.74M).

Services for families

The centre will house:

- Albert Park College Child Care Centre (APCCC)
- Lady Forster Kindergarten (LFK)
- Maternal and child health services
- Playgroups

In addition, meeting rooms will be available for community use after hours.

Why an integrated family and children's centre?

Integrated family and children's centres bring together accessible and affordable care, education and health services for families with children aged 0-8 years. The centre will provide these services in a coordinated, flexible and creative way that benefits children and families, particularly those experiencing difficulties. The collaborative model ensures a consistent level of service to families using the various service types. The integrated family and children's services centre is one of the ways council is supporting and expanding accessible, quality children's services in our city.
