In 2018 Parks Victoria were given \$5million by the State Government to spend on Community Sporting Infrastructure within Albert Park Reserve. Have Parks Victoria indicated what that money will be spent on, or is it still sitting in a Parks Victoria bank account waiting to be spent?

Response

Officers from City of Port Phillip consulted Sport and Recreation Victoria to find out the status of the state funding commitment of \$5M to spend on community sporting infrastructure within Albert Park Reserve.

In response \$3.2M, has been allocated for the development of a new community pavilion adjacent to Oval One. The remaining funds will be allocated by Parks Victoria to other projects that increase the capacity of sporting assets. These will be decided in conjunction with the sporting clubs at Albert Park.
