Questions from Steven Palos:

Question - With regard to the closure of Ferrars Street, Gladstone Street and Railway Place, what traffic management impact studies have been undertaken to arrive at the decision the three roads can be closed, and if these have been done, where do I access that traffic management impact study?

Response - We have had more than eight reports come up and in the original stages of this process we had traffic management studies as attachments to public reports. Mr Traill took this question on notice to provide specific dates of these reports.

Manager confirms that follow up contact was made with the resident to discuss the assessments undertaken by Council in regards to traffic management and road closures in the vicinity of Ferrars Street Education & Community Precinct.
