Terms and Conditions

Do not drive the wheelchair:

- Beyond restrictions indicated in the powered wheelchair user manual, for example maximum inclines, kerb height etc.
- In places or on surfaces where a loss of wheel grip could be hazardous, for example on wet grassy slopes.
- If the controller or other crucial components are known to require repair.

<u>Your powered wheelchair has electric motors and must NEVER be driven</u> <u>through water, into rivers, creeks and the sea.</u>
