Flood preparation video

Transcript

City of Port Phillip has been identified as one of the most at risk locations in Victoria for flooding.

Flood waters can rise very quickly, they can be very deep and they often do it without warning.

You can learn more about the risk of flood in your area by getting a hold of the local flood guide and that's available on the SES Vic website.

In terms of preparing for storms and floods make sure that your gutters and drains are clean, that objects outside are secured down and that valuable items are lifted up off the floor.

People need to make sure that they are fully covered for flood in Port Phillip.

When there's a storm on the way, keep an eye on the Bureau of Meteorology information and Vic Emergency Services app.

Never drive through flood waters because a very shallow depth of 15 cm can float a car.

So stay safe by avoiding flooded areas.
