Definition: For the purposes of this document, we will use the term 'Deaf and Disabled people'. This aligns to the Social Model of Disability outlined below. Disability can be visible or invisible, sensory, physical, neurodiverse, cognitive, intellectual or developmental. Our definition includes people with lived experience of mental health or illness. We use this definition as an act of pride and solidarity. Disabled people are diverse and have intersecting identities; they are never just disabled people. The terms Deaf and Disabled people are linked to a cultural identity and experience. We recognise and support the right of the Deaf community to label their experiences not as disability, but as one of cultural and linguistic difference.
