The following information must be provided as appropriate. □ An A3 plan that is fully dimensioned, has a north arrow, is to scale (i.e. 1:100 @ A3), and includes a scale bar, showing: □ The location, shape and size of the site. □ The location, length, height and design of the proposed fence including details of materials. The location, height and design of any existing front fence on adjoining and nearby properties including details of materials. □ A photograph of the site and adjoining and nearby properties along the street frontage. □ The reason for the proposed height.
