

Public Question Time – answers to questions taken on notice*

Questioned the blame of community problems that had been unfairly attributed to the St Kilda Drumming group.

The Mayor, Cr Voss, asked if there was any feedback on the drumming.

Response

A gathering of drummers and spectators are meeting at the St Kilda Beach foreshore, western end, on a weekly basis. The drummers are an informal gathering of people and therefore do not require a permit.

This year three residents living adjacent to The Esplanade have made a complaint about the drummers and one resident has praised the drumming. Council's Local Laws staff are investigating the complaints.

In accordance with Council's Local Law No.1 (Community Amenity) the drummers can meet on the foreshore provided they do not interfere with the quiet enjoyment of other people using the Council land or living in close proximity to the Council land.
