

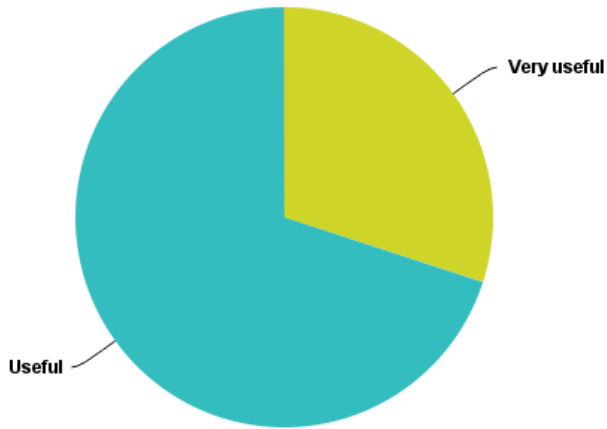
FB Community Forum Survey Results (May 2016)

Urban Renewal Area



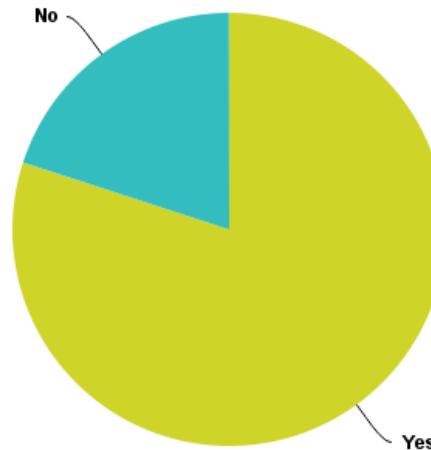
Q1 How useful is the information provided in the Fishermans Bend Community Forum Meetings?

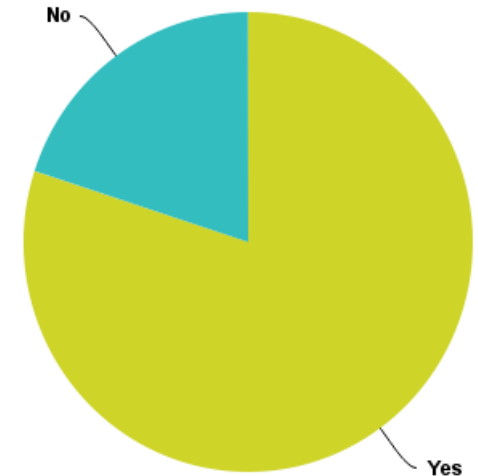
Q2 Are you happy with the range of topics covered?

Feedback:

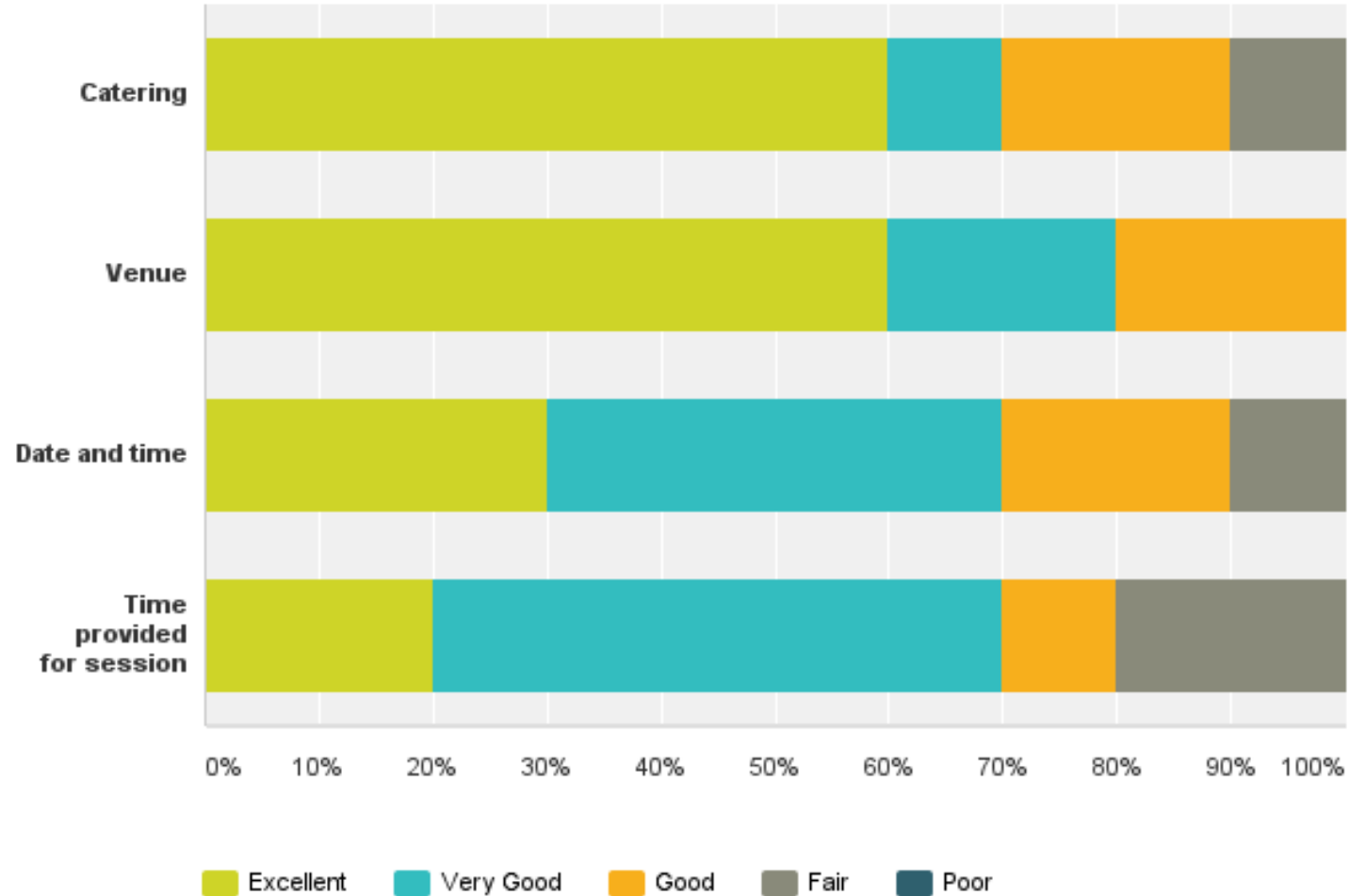
- That the forum was formed and is meeting.

- Circulation of presentations in advance of the meeting to allow a more informed discussions.
- More discussion time, especially regarding urban environmental sustainability, and health and safety issues for an emerging and ageing population.
- Private enterprises should attend to present their views, including architects describing their briefs from developers to compare their understanding of the area and liveability.
- Opportunity to hear from the Minister for Planning on the State Government's approach to planning and development of Fishermans Bend.
- Clarity is required on what the Victorian Government will do to respond to prevailing concerns.
- A more strident community forum is required.
- As the development of Fishermans Bend continues the issues will become more numerous and complex; the challenge is to keep a step ahead of the Victorian Government so the Community Forum can identify and advocate on issues the community views as important that may otherwise have been overlooked.
- Too many acceptances and assumptions have been factored into the development of Fishermans Bend. Great efforts are being made to accommodate what amounts to a very poor State Government planning decision in the first place.
