The CCTV has been installed to enable monitoring and evaluation activities to occur to capture the following:

- 1. User legibility and comprehension
- 2. Near misses & queue lengths
- 3. Cyclist, pedestrian, and vehicle counts

CCTV has been installed at the following 5 locations in CoPP:
