



#### Notes:

1. Temporary crossing under six (6) weeks duration to be of Timber or Chequered Steel Plate.
2. Temporary crossings in excess of six (6) weeks to be of semi-permanent construction with asphalt or concrete.
3. The permit holder to make sure temporary vehicle crossing material should be slip resistant.
4. This is not a permit, a Temporary Vehicle Crossing Permit must be obtained from the City of Port Phillip.
5. This does not apply for permanent/ long term installation.
6. Galvanised Steel pipe to be maintained and cleaned all times.
7. Any damage to Council's asset may incur a penalty and must be reinstated at the applicants cost to Council satisfaction.
8. Only to be used where approved by Council. The permit holder accepts responsibility for regular maintenance of the asset, including the removal of leaves and any other obstructions impacting on the flow of stormwater.
9. Where concrete is required to be removed due to proposed works of any kind, the entire area between construction joints must be replaced in full.
10. All dimensions are in millimetres unless noted otherwise.
