Engagement activities

The engagement activities for the Park Street Streetscape Project will include:

- Letterbox notification to properties surrounding the corridor (including businesses)
- Corflute signage placed along the street
- Website update
- Have Your Say survey with Frequently Asked Questions open for four weeks
- Meeting with key local stakeholders
- Drop-in sessions (COVID-19 health advice dependent)
- Social media posts.

Affected residents and businesses will be sent a letter to ensure they are aware of the Park Street Streetscape Improvement Project engagement, with clear information on how they can provide feedback.

Have Your Say survey:

The survey questions reflect previous engagement undertaken as part of the Domain Precinct Masterplan, which canvassed community sentiment about the Park Street streetscape and installation of a protected bike lane. The following is a summary of the feedback being sought on the concept design:

- 1. Does the proposed landscaping interventions meet the community's expectations?
- 2. How does the community currently use on-street parking?
- 3. How does the community want to use on-street parking in the future (through choice of parking controls)?
- 4. Does the design provide sufficient user amenity such as street furniture and bike parking?
- 5. Does the community wish to see dedicated provision for dockless bikes and escooters on Park Street?
- 6. How can the proposed design of the streetscape best support your business?
- 7. Any other feedback on the streetscape improvements design?
