Reason for Review	The presence of the Corona Virus and government advice regarding social gatherings and vulnerable groups.
Risk Assessment	Further assessment of risk as many of the participants are aged and therefore in a vulnerable cohort. Events and programs take place in public venues. Continuing the service may increase the opportunity for transmission of the virus.
Community Assessment	This will remove a small, but well-loved program for the period of the virus. It provides opportunities for residents to socialise.
Economic Assessment	External local sole trader contractors (historians/guest speakers) have been engaged so approx. \$1,200 in fees will be honoured regardless of whether these events go ahead or not.
Options	Option 1 Suspend the program and explore whether programs can be rescheduled to later in the year. (recommended) Option 2 Keep the service open and implement risk mitigation (not recommended). The service has a higher uptake of older people who are at greater risk.
