

## **Councillor Question Time – answers to questions taken on notice\***

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### **Question from Councillor Voss**

Councillor Voss asked how the implementation of PayStay signage is going?

### **Response**

The Paystay phone payment system became active for customers in the City of Port Phillip on 17 Oct with PayStay signage installations commencing on that day.

Once the signs are installed in an area, customers can start using the PayStay system. Installation of PayStay signs in the Fishermans Bend area commenced the week beginning November 5, however the street parking signs were covered until the restrictions became active so paid parking started on November 12.

The installation of PayStay signs across all paid parking locations in the City of Port Phillip is almost complete with only Pier Road and Shakespeare Grove carpark to be completed.
