

Public Question Time

Questions from Adrian Jackson:

Why is the state government sponsored Armstrong St, Middle Park, platform (near the palm tree) now fenced off with a mesh fence? Has the novelty worn off? Is it an OH&S problem? Is it unsightly and out of place after destroying the grass that was there? Will the two litter bins be returned to Armstrong St next to the footpath where they were more useful to passing pedestrians? Will the oversized concrete slab near the platform be removed? Councillors will you get this pocket park back to what it used to be like?

Response:

The deck was being oiled to ensure longevity and freshen up the infrastructure in time for spring. The fence was in place for one day while the oil dried and has now been removed. There were no OHS problems identified. The litter bins that were previously on Armstrong Street have been relocated to the new seating and information board location on Erskine Street. As these bins have been relocated there are no plans to reinstate bins at the Armstrong Street location. Council is not aware of a concrete slab near the platform. There are no immediate plans to remove the concrete slab where the litter bins were located on Armstrong Street.
