## **Councillor Question Time**

## **Question from Councillor Pearl:**

Can officers provide an update on installation of lighting in Tarver Street, Port Melbourne?

## Response

Tarver Street is transitioning from a commercial/industrial precinct to a commercial/residential precinct. The current streetlight arrangement reflects the historical use of the area with streetlights illuminated Tarver Street at the intersections with Prohasky, Smith and Salmon Street.

Council officers are currently working with a developer to design and install streetlights along Tarver Street (Salmon Street to Smith Street). The streetlights are expected to be operational prior to the site's practical completion.

The installation of public lighting in the section of Tarver Street between Prohasky to Smith Street will be further considered as part of the broader planning being undertaken for Fishermans Bend.
