## **Councillor Question Time**

## **Question from Councillor Bond:**

Were detailed designs of the Department of Transport (DoT) Pop Up bike lane bollards and their location provided by officers prior to their installation?

## Response:

Council officers reviewed the DoT pop up bike lane design packages against technical standards and confirmed delegated support for the approval of the designs being carried out as trials, subject to minor design amendments. Following further discussion with DoT, these amendments were generally adopted within the final design and delivery approach.

The full design package, which included bollards and bolt down islands and separators as per the final installation, was considered to be consistent with the location specific design snapshots that DoT provided within their <u>online consultation map</u>. The link to this was provided to Councillors with all communications on this matter. The design package was also consistent with the look and feel of material provided to Councillors within briefing presentations (attached), and to the community through the <u>DoT pop up bike lane website</u>.
