Dear Emma,

Following is our fifth annual report as required under clause 16 of the Palais Theatre Lease Agreement.

16.1 Annual Report

A) Repairs & Maintenance Works

While all statutory compliance work and general maintenance of the venue continued throughout 2021/22 COVID impacted period. The level of R&M spend has increased significantly this year due to increase show count and attendances and, also due to the additional costs related to COVID safe equipment, signage, sanitising, and cleaning which are now ongoing costs to the business. Below is a summary from 1^{st} May 2021 – 30^{th} April 2022.

B) Booking Schedule

2021 Event Schedule

As per the previous year, the event schedule is presented on a calendar year basis, which aligns with Live Nation's reporting, statistical and tracking systems.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, we closed and reopened on at least four occasions during 2021, delivering content whenever the opportunity arose between lockdowns, with the majority of shows rescheduled or cancelled.

We have now been reopened since December 2021, and it took around three months to build up show count momentum. Since March of this year, up until the date of this report, the Palais Theatre has experiencing one of the busiest periods in our operating history. In April 2022, Palais conducted a record-breaking 22 shows and 47,394 patrons for the month.

During 2021, we held the following ticketed and non ticketed bookings:

- 41 ticketed performances (Up 78% on 2020)
- 21 different events
- 42K ticketed attendees (up 21% on 2020)

C) Community Reservation Periods

(i) Use of Premises in accordance with clause 11

- Under the Palais Theatre lease agreement, Live Nation are to provide up to eight days a year for Community Reservations at a rental rate of \$1 per day, plus costs and GST. During 2021/2022, due to lockdowns, we conducted one designated Community Reservation Event, that being Sacred Heart Mission's Dine with Heart which was conducted successfully in May 2022.
- Other noteworthy community reservations provided free of charge, that were not designated as formal Community Reservations under the lease were:
 - o St Kilda Festival filming interviews with New Music Stage participants
 - Free community venue access was provided to several not-for-profit photography and filming projects, stage access was provided for ballet dancers, venue tours and Cinema Spaces Filming project.
 - Crew Care Training.
 - Roadies for Roadies fundraiser.
- Live Nation continued to offer their special discounted rental rate for schools of \$6,750 plus costs and GST, which usually enables several local schools to host their annual concert. Unfortunately, due to the pandemic, no schools held their concerts in 2021.
- Live Nation decided to merge It's discounted rental offer for schools, charities and not for profits events that are not listed by the City of Port Phillip as one of there 8 designated events each year, in to the one heavily discounted rate of \$6,750 plus costs and GST (standard rental is a minimum of \$13,000 plus costs, plus GST). Previously the rental rate offered to charities and not for profits organisations was \$9,375 plus costs and GST.

(ii) Palais Theatre Community Fund (PTCF)

Up to the end of April, the PTCF had raised \$293,458.85 solely from Live Nation donating \$0.50 from every ticket sold at the venue. The program has now delivered six rounds of community grants, with the seventh round currently in final stages of allocating the funds.

Round 6 grant program was conducted in November 2021. The committee focussed its promotional reach on those community organisations who may need assistance in reopening after the pandemic. Due to the smaller accumulation of funds caused by the pandemic, The PTCF Committee decided to allocate up to \$3,000 per grant, instead of the normal \$5,000 per grant, so we were able to share around grants to more community groups.

The PTCF committee selected the following successful applicants, with funds totalling \$16,000:

• Artists for Kids Culture – a 2-day festival "Your Fest" at South Melbourne Community Centre for kids' art, workshops and performances.

- St Kilda Scout Group
 Creating a Veggie Garden by the hall as they reopened and reactivated their space.
- Rawcus Theatre Company Inc "Incursions Project" engaging four artists to run a workshop to engage potential new collaborators for a new work.
- Space2b Social Design 'In Our shoes', a group art exhibition and professional training
 program for CALD (Culturally and Linguistically Diverse) artists that celebrate home,
 belonging and their personal experiences of settlement in a new country.
- The National Theatre Funding live mix multiple camera setup for use for their hirers to provide inclusivity for those who cannot attend.
- Elwood Toy Library– New scooters and Ezyrollers at the toy library
- Linden New Art Inc "On Holidays at Linden" a community engagement project targeting local families and features colourful images of artworks.

Space2b (Round 6)

"The exhibition invited the audience (locals) to 'step into the shoes' of someone new to our shores and gain a better understanding of the experience of making a new home, thereby deepening understanding of the journey to 'belong'. Feedback from people who attended the opening and our volunteers said that the stories had increased their knowledge and understanding of refugees and settlement."

Artist for Kids Culture (Round 6)

"The Palais Theatre Community Fund supported our organisation to host an inclusive and quality arts event for the local community. The donation allowed us to open the event with a Welcome to Country and story time for kids and families. We were able to pay local musicians and artists for their incredible contributions of live music and arts activities at the event."

Rawcus (Round 6)

"The Rawcus Ensemble consists of artists with and without disability and Incursions offered them an opportunity to undertake workshops with other artists providing professional skill development as well as enabling all the artists to explore the possibilities of creating a new work for delivery in the City of Port Phillip"

Community Advisory and Community Fund Committee

By November 2021, all the Palais Theatre Community Fund Committee (PTCFC) Members had served on the PTCFC for an extended period, the extended period was due to the initial establishment of the PTCF and the impacts of covid-19 during 2020 & 2021. All members concluded their term on the Committee at the conclusion of round 6. We thank all the committee for their time and experience they brought to the Fund and this includes Melissa Grenville, Liz Johnstone Julie Mundy, Sue Roff, and Jaimie Brunton. The above PTCFC met to review and decide the successful applications for round 6.

In January 2022, we advertised and recruited a new PTCFC from City of Port Philip residents. The new PTCFC includes Fiona Healy, John Beard, Catherine Easton, Jo Daniell, Madeline Getson & Maya Weiss. The PTCFC has met to review and discuss the applications for Round Seven and have received some great ideas on extending the reach of the Palais Theatre Community Fund.

D) Grants and Support

Live Nation Australia Venues (LNAV) would like to firstly thank COPP for their continued rental relief scheme, where between May 21 – April 22, Live Nation Australia Venues as the operator of the Palais Theatre were granted \$500,805 in rental relief.

LNAV during the pandemic also applied for any available covid-19 funding opportunities from both the State & Federal Governments level. The grants received were as follows.

Both the Creative Victoria Grant & the RISE Grant will be used to execute a series of shows, on the Palais stage during January 2023, with the focus being to support and accelerate the careers for developing musicians, production crew and students through a series of intimate and unique on stage events at the Palais Theatre.

16.2 Annual Forecast

A) Management of Assets & Facilities.

As agreed on completion of the Year 4 annual report, the total BISF spent up to that date was \$2,620,198. This results in Live Nation having a credit balance within the BISF program for an amount of \$559,935.

For the 2021/22 period the indexed BISF obligation (@ 0.8%) was \$535,872. Live Nation Australia Venues had no obligation under the lease to undertake further BISF works for this year to meet the BISF schedule.

Despite this, \$15,000 was spent on upgrading the POS system. With a further \$63,500 expected to be spent on air-conditioning works this financial year.
