

Public Question Time – answers to questions taken on notice*

Question from Isaac Hermann:

Q1 Why has flood safety signage been removed from the corner of Glen Huntly Rd and St Kilda St?

Response

You asked a question regarding flood warning signage on the corner of St Kilda St and Glenhuntly Rd. I followed this up with our Transport Safety Engineering team and they noted that both roads are declared state roads and the intersection and signage is state (VicRoads) controlled. Signage removal would be at VicRoads' discretion, and presumably they did not find it warranted.

Our team coordinator has no recollection of signage such as this at that intersection, and a scan of relatively recent historical images could find no evidence of it. We do have signage related to flooding at Foam St, where it fords the canal.
