10.1 Kerferd Road Safety Trial Update

Question from Councillor Pearl:

Can officers provide the following in relation to the Kerferd Road safety trial?

- A summary of the known accidents around this intersection
- Evidence of the safety concerns regarding rear-end collisions at the nearby intersection.

Response:

Kerferd Road between Beaconsfield Parade and Canterbury Road is defined as a road safety 'black length'. The intersection of Kerferd Road with Herbert and Montague Streets has had one recorded crash in the past five years. Over the most recent ten year period (between January 2011 and December 2021), there were five recorded crashes at Montague Street/Kerferd Road (two in 2012; two in 2013, one in 2020)

Officers can confirm that there have been no reported crashes (including rear endings) at this location since February 2021 when the trial was installed.
