

**Councillor Question Time – answers to questions taken on notice\***

**Question from Cr Bond**

Cr Bond asked, in relation to Fitzroy Street, which was “marked up” months ago to have all the damaged service pits repaired, when this work will occur?

**Response**

Paving works have begun on Fitzroy Street and over the past couple of weeks our contractors have replaced or reset a number of defective service valve covers and also made safe some uneven pavers outside the light rail stop.

In the next couple of weeks, the remaining service valve covers will be repaired, along with defective stormwater pit lids. Grout fill of pavers will also occur at a number of locations. Other identified rectification works will be undertaken as contractors are available.

We have begun a project with service providers to ensure they reinstate the pavement appropriately for any future works.
