PIER ROAD CLOSURE, ST KILDA

Parks Victoria's St Kilda Pier redevelopment project aims to extend the pier landing to Jacka Boulevard. Creating an improved entrance while respecting the site's history and function.

The St Kilda Pier Landside Works will create a public space that enhances the Pier's iconic status and improve connections for bikes and pedestrians. To achieve this, the southern section of Pier Road needs to be closed to vehicles, between Royal Melbourne Yacht Squadron and Jacka Boulevard. The road will be closed in stages with the section closest to the Pier first. Prior to closing the road all the way to Jacka Boulevard, the entrance to the St Kilda Sea Baths carpark will be reconfigured to ensure no impact to visitor amenity or trade. Full access will be retained to Pier Road from the West Beach (northern) end.

To restrict the passage of vehicles on the section of Pier Road between Jacka Boulevard and the Royal Melbourne Yacht Squadron, we are commencing legal procedures in accordance with the Local Government Act 1989 (the Act), Section 207 (Power of Council over traffic) and Schedule 11, Clause 9 (Power to place obstructions or barriers on a road permanently) (known as the 'road closure').
