Response

Council is responsible for the cleaning and maintenance of the public toilets including the disabled toilet at the St Kilda Life Saving Club. Since the question was raised, the vandalised door has been fixed and is now functional. With the new Cleaning contract in place, the toilets will be cleaned regularly as per the cleaning schedule for our public toilets.
