INSTRUMENT OF DELEGATION
For the SOUTH MELBOURNE MARKET COMMITTEE**

Authorising Provision

This Instrument of Delegation is made pursuant to section 86(3) of the *Local Government Act 1989*.

Port Phillip City Council delegates to the committee established by resolution of Council passed on 26 February 2001 and known as the **South Melbourne Market Committee** (the Committee), the powers, discretions and authorities set out below:

- Absolute authority to do all things necessary to manage the Market in terms consistent with:
 - a) the 5 year Strategic Plan approved by Council
 - b) the annual Business Plan approved by Council
 - c) Council's wider plans and objectives, in particular specific community and environmental goals required by Council
 - d) the MoU between Council and the Section 86 Committee

This Instrument of Delegation is authorised by a resolution of Council passed on 14 July 2015.

The delegation comes into force immediately the Common Seal of Council is affixed to this Instrument of Delegation.

The delegation remains in force until Council resolves to vary or revoke it.
