1. PURPOSE

- 1.1 The purpose of this item is to report to Council written records of Assemblies of Councillors at the City of Port Phillip as required by section 80A (2) (a) and (b) of the *Local Government Act 1989*.

2. RECOMMENDATION

That Council:

- 2.1 Receives and notes the written records of Assemblies of Councillors (attached) as required by section 80A (2) (a) and (b) of the *Local Government Act 1989*.

3. KEY POINTS/ISSUES

- 3.1 An Assembly of Councillors is defined in the Local Government Act 1989 as meaning an advisory committee of the Council, at least one Councillor is present, or a planned or scheduled meeting of at least half of the Councillors and one member of Council staff which considers matters that are intended or likely to be the subject of a decision of the Council or subject to the exercise of a function, duty or power of the Council that has been delegated to a person or committee. The definition excludes a meeting of the Council, a special committee of the Council, an audit committee, a club, association, peak body, political party or other organisation.
- 3.2 This report (Attachment 1) includes records of the Assemblies of Councillors that have occurred since 5 February 2018.
