NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CLOSE SECTIONS OF ROAD NEAR CORNER GRAHAM AND STATION STREETS, PORT MELBOURNE

Port Phillip City Council ("Council") acting as the responsible road authority under s 37 of the Road Management Act 2004 gives notice under Clause 10 of Schedule 11 of the Local Government Act 1989 ("Act") that Council proposes to restrict the passage of vehicles to the parking area and adjacent space beneath the Graham Street Overpass so as to prevent any injury to any person or damage to any property, as shown shaded on the image below.



The closure of these sections of road is being proposed in line with Council's Public Space Strategy, aimed at improving the quality and diversity of the Graham Street Underpass in Port Melbourne to increase its appeal and level of use. The existing skatepark will be updated and extended to create a contemporary skate facility with social space, and future provision for further recreational facilities.
A person may make a written submission on the proposal in accordance with s 223 of the Act. Interested persons are invited to make a written submission to Council by Tuesday, 19 February 2024.
