This cohort often lacks the interpersonal skills to negotiate an appointment-based system and may have behavioural issues leading to exclusions from medical clinics. CS1812	Sacred Heart Mission	Hands on Health Clinic	Sacred Heart Mission's Hands on Health Clinic provides complementary health and wellbeing services for people who are disadvantaged and/or homeless in the City of Port Phillip. Its services are delivered by skilled volunteers and focuses on community engagement and social participation. It offers therapies disadvantaged people cannot generally afford.
